# How to get to Lodz?



## Railway transport

Near the railway stations there are tram and bus stops allowing access to any place in the city. When leaving the stations, there are also zones for taxis. A walk from Lodz Kaliska Railway Station to the university and dormitories takes about 20 – 30 minutes.

The main railway stations in Lodz: Lodz Kaliska, Lodz Fabryczna.
